

**THE CORPORATION OF THE

BY-LAW 2007- 053

**TOWN OF BRADFORD WEST GWILLIMBURY
ACCESSIBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (AAC)**

Being a By-Law of the Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to appoint members to the Bradford West Gwillimbury Accessibility Advisory Committee.

WHEREAS Subsection 29 (1) of the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 provides that the council of every municipality having a population of not less than 10,000 shall establish an accessibility advisory committee or continue any such Committee that was established before the day this section comes into force.

AND WHEREAS Subsection 29(3) of the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 provides that the majority of the members of the committee shall be persons with disabilities.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable for the health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants and workers of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to develop an Accessibility Advisory Committee.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury confirmed the composition and term of Bradford West Gwillimbury Accessibility Advisory Committee under resolution 34-031 on September 17, 2002.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF BRADFORD WEST GWILLIMBURY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1 COMPOSITION

1.1 That the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury do hereby confirm the appointment of the following individuals as listed to the Bradford West Gwillimbury Accessibility Advisory Committee.

- 1.2 That the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury do confirm the appointment of the following Members of Council as listed to the Bradford West Gwillimbury Accessibility Advisory Committee

2 TERM

- 2.1 The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury confirm the term of the appointments to the Accessibility Advisory Committee to be concurrent with the term of Council. Therefore, the term of appointment to be to May 1, 2007 to November 30, 2010.

3 DUTIES OF COMMITTEE

- 3.1 The Accessibility Advisory Committee shall:

3.1.1 advise the council about the requirements and implementation of accessibility standards and the preparation of accessibility reports and such other matters for which the council may seek its advice under subsection (5) of the Act;

3.1.2 review in a timely manner the site plans and drawings described in section 41 of the *Planning Act* that the committee selects;

3.1.3 perform all other functions that are specified in the regulations.

4 CONFLICTING LEGISLATION

- 4.1 If this By-Law conflicts with the provisions of any Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 the provisions of the Act prevail to the extent of the conflict.

5 VALIDITY AND SEVERABILITY

5.1 It is hereby declared that notwithstanding any section, subsections, clause, paragraph or provision of the By-Law or parts thereof, may be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unenforceable, illegal or beyond the powers of Council to enact, such section or sections or parts thereof shall be deemed to be severable and that all other sections or parts of this By-Law are separate and independent therefrom and enacted as such as a whole. Same shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provisions of this By-Law or of the By-Law as a whole.

5.2 Whenever any reference is made in this By-Law to a statute of the Legislature of the Province of Ontario, such reference shall be deemed to include all subsequent amendments to such statute and all successor legislation to such statute.

6 SHORT TITLE

6.1 This By-Law shall be cited as the BRADFORD WEST GWILLIMBURY
ACCESSIBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS (2007-2010)
By-Law.

7 FORCE AND EFFECT


7.1 This By-Law shall take effect and become in full force and effect upon the day of
