NOTICE TO RESIDENTS WATERMAIN CLEANING PROGRAM

Please be advised that the 2009 watermain cleaning (swabbing) will be undertaken at the following areas **between the hours of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am commencing the evening of Sunday April 26/09 and finishing the morning of Friday May 1/09.**

Barrie St. from Fletcher St. to Holland St.
Holland St. West from Barrie St. to Professor Day Dr.
Northgate Dr. from Fox Run Lane to Hudson Cres.
Carrington Place, Church St., Compton Cres., David St., Essa St., Fletcher St., Fox Run Lane, Frederick St., Harmony Circle, Holland Crt., Hurd St., James St., John St., Joseph St., Moore St., Queen St., Rebecca St., Stoddard Crt., Thornton Ave., Toronto St. and Tower Crt.

It is recommended that customers DO NOT use water during the specified period of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am as you could experience partial or complete loss of pressure during the swabbing process.

Individual door notices will be hand delivered to residents a few days before, advising them of the watermain cleaning taking place on their street.

In the morning, if you experience any discoloured water, please turn on the cold water in your laundry tub or bath tub, whichever is furthest back in the house, away from your water meter and allow that water to run for up to five minutes or until clear. If the water does not clear up after this point or you experience pressure loss, please contact the Water Department at 905-778-2055.
