## PUBLIC MEETING

### ZONING BY-LAW CONSOLIDATION PROJECT APPLIES TO ALL LANDS IN THE TOWN OF BRADFORD WEST GWILLIMBURY

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING ON THE PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW CONSOLIDATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 34 (12) OF THE PLANNING ACT, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, AS AMENDED

#### What's a Zoning By-law?

A Zoning By-law is a document that regulates all properties in the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury. Each zone regulates land use, setbacks, building height, lot coverage, lot area, parking permissions, and other legal clauses that guide staff, applicants, and the public to administrate land use rights within the Town.

#### What's a Zoning By-law consolidation?

The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury is an amalgam of the former Town of Bradford, Township of West Gwillimbury, and a portion of the Township of Tecumseth. Each of these former municipalities is subject to its own pre-amalgamation zoning by-laws, all of which were enacted prior to 1981. The review and consolidation process seeks to update the antiquated zoning by-laws to reflect new and progressive land use tools now available to municipalities as well as to conform with recently published Provincial and County planning documents. The end result will be a zoning by-law that is easily understood by the public and the development community while being flexible, consistent, and enforceable by the Town.

#### How do I find out more information?

The Town is hosting a public meeting on Wednesday, May 13, 2009, at 7:00 pm. The public meeting will be held at the Community Centre Auditorium at 125 Simcoe Road, Bradford.

The purpose of the public meeting is to inform the public of the nature of the proposal, invite public input, and answer questions regarding the proposed by-law.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of Council in respect of the proposed zoning by-law, you must make a written request to Patricia Nash, Municipal Clerk, Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury, 100 Dissette Street, Units 7 & 8, P.O. Box 100, Bradford, Ontario, L3Z 2A7, fax 905-775-0153.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
