NOTICE TO RESIDENTS WATERMAIN CLEANING PROGRAM

Please be advised that the 2009 watermain cleaning (swabbing) will be undertaken on **Simcoe Road from Veseli Court to Canal Road between the hours of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am on one of the following evenings: May 12, 13 or 14, 2009.**

Individual door notices will be hand delivered to residents a few days before, advising them of the date in which the watermain cleaning will be taking place.

It is recommended that customers DO NOT use water during the specified period of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am as you could experience partial or complete loss of pressure during the swabbing process.

In the morning, if you experience any discoloured water, please turn on the cold water in your laundry tub or bath tub, whichever is furthest back in the house, away from your water meter and allow that water to run for up to five minutes or until clear. If the water does not clear up after this point or you experience pressure loss, please contact the Water Department at 905-778-2055. **Thank you for your patience.**
