TRIBUNAL ORDER

**IN THE MATTER OF THE DRAINAGE ACT, R.S.O.1990, C.D.17 AS
AMENDED.**

AND IN THE MATTER OF: Appeals to the Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs Appeal Tribunal by **Barlow Square Inc., Sudbury; Martin and Maria Bonigut, Newmarket; Henry Kedra, Guelph; Gary Rupke, Kettleby; and Salvatore Tunno, Kettleby** under Subsection 48(1) of the *Drainage Act* from the engineer's report and by **the County of Simcoe, Midhurst; Dorian and Elizabeth Milleman, Newmarket; and Nabil Salama, Toronto** under Subsection 54(1) of the *Drainage Act* from a decision of the Court of Revision, and by **Lawrence and Connie Curtis, Bradford; and Ron Gleason, Bradford** under Subsection 48(1) and 54(1) of the *Drainage Act* on the **Holland Marsh Drainage System Canal Improvement Project** initiated by the **Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury**.

The notice of appeal has identified proposed modifications to the proposed drainage works, inadequacy of allowances and changes to the assessment of costs of the drainage works. Because this appeal may result in the Tribunal ordering a change in the assessment proposed in the report, the Tribunal orders that:

1. All persons assessed or compensated for the drainage works as shown in the engineer's report are made parties to the hearing and the notice of hearing is to contain a clause to notify the assessed parties of this decision of the Tribunal.
