#### **Important Notice 2010 Property Tax Bills**

The 2010 Interim property tax bills were mailed out on February 5, 2010. Tax bills were issued for each of the following tax classes; residential, multi-residential, commercial, industrial, pipeline, farm and managed forests. The due dates are the same for all tax classes; first instalment due **February 26, 2010** and second instalment due **April 30, 2010**. Please note these bills represent no more than 50% of the previous year's annualized taxes levied.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not excuse the property owner from the responsibility for payment, nor relieve him/her from liability of penalty for late payment.

The Ontario Government has made a number of changes to the Request for Reconsideration (RfR) and Appeal process including the deadline for filing a RfR with the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC). **The new deadline for filing a RfR with MPAC is March 31, 2010 for the 2010 property tax year.** For more information, visit [www.mpac.ca](http://www.mpac.ca) or call 1-866-296-MPAC(6722).

#### **2009 ANNUAL SUMMARY COMPLIANCE REPORTS**

The Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury Engineering Department is pleased to announce that in accordance with the Safe Drinking Water act 2002, Ontario Regulation 170/03 under the Ontario Water Resources Act (OWRA), the 2009 Annual Summary Compliance report will be posted on the Town's website as of February 28, 2010. In addition, the combined 2009 Annual Summary Compliance Report and the Permit to Take Water Report will be going to the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury Council in March and will be placed on the Town's website before the end of March 2010.

As per the requirements, the owner of the drinking water system shall ensure that every time an annual report is prepared, effective steps are taken to advise users of water from the system, the copies of the report are available without charge (at the front desk of the Town's Engineering Office at 31 Barrie Street, hard copies for viewing are available), during regular business hours of 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.
